

PRESCHOOL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The following items must be on file before the first day of school.

- * Birth Certificate
- * Immunization Record (DH 680) - must be up-to-date
- * Physical Form (DH 3040) - can not be more than two years old
- * Four year olds - VPK Certificate of Eligibility

Contact Information

It is imperative that you keep us up to date on any changes of cell phones/work numbers. It is important that we be able to contact you, if necessary, while your child is at school.

Dress Code

*Preschool students should be dressed in age and weather appropriate, comfortable clothing that they can handle themselves. Overalls and belts are discouraged because preschoolers have a very difficult time managing them and this leads to frustration and an increase in toiling accidents. Elastic-waist pants, shorts and skorts are best.

*Clothing should be neat and clean, but not clothing that is not ok to play in! Students will be exposed to many different play experiences including play-doh, painting, coloring, pasting, etc. Weather permitting, students will spend a large portion of their day playing outside and is likely to get dirty.

*Shoes should be comfortable and completely closed in. For your child's safety, sandals, flip flops and shoes or boots that have a heel are not permitted.

Meals & Snacks

All students must bring a morning snack to school. Students who stay past 11:30 will need to bring a packed lunch Pre-school children will not be allowed to bring microwaveable lunches to school. After school provides a snack in the afternoon.

Nap

All preschoolers who stay past 11:30AM will need a small pillow and blanket for naps. These items must be small enough to fit inside your child's cubbie.

All preschool students must be completely potty-trained. Children still have accidents and need to have 2 complete change of clothes on campus.
